Example Paragraph Question:

Surveys are often conducted to find out which poems are most popular among teachers, readers' groups, or the general public. According to their findings, *I Wandered Lonely as a Cloud*, the best-known poem by William Wordsworth, regularly ranks among the top ten. The poem's appeal more than two centuries after its initial publication attests to its lasting power to touch readers' hearts and minds. Wordsworth was born in 1770 in the Lake District of England, a mountainous region widely regarded as one of the most scenic areas of Europe. As a young man, he developed a keen interest in poetry that was matched only by his fascination with the natural environment. He was an avid walker, exploring not only his native country but France, Switzerland, and Italy, too. In 1795, a chance encounter brought Wordsworth together with the poet Samuel Taylor Coleridge. The meeting was to prove a watershed moment in literary history. Wordsworth and Coleridge immediately recognized each other as kindred spirits because of their similar poetic interests, and over the next few years, they spent countless hours in each other's company. They were both in their early 20s, highly influenced by the ideals of the French Revolution, and inspired to write poetry that would break

with what they saw as the stifling traditions of contemporary English poetry. Their partnership, which involved mutual criticism as well as collaboration, proved to be the starting point for the English Romantic period. Their collection of poems, *Lyrical Ballads*, is considered a masterpiece of English literature. The collection includes mostly work by Wordsworth, but it also features the compelling *Rime of the Ancient Mariner*, which guaranteed Coleridge a place in literary history.
