Wolves have lived on Earth for more than one million years. They spread across North America, Europe, and Asia. Wolves were able to survive in many different climates, from cold Arctic areas to warm forests and plains. Because of this, they became one of the most successful carnivores in history.

Wolves live in groups called packs. A pack is usually led by an alpha male and an alpha female. The members of the pack cooperate in hunting, raising their young, and defending their territory. Wolves also communicate with each other by howling. Their teamwork made them excellent hunters.

For thousands of years, humans have had mixed feelings about wolves. Some people admired their strength and loyalty, while others feared them. Farmers often saw wolves as a danger to their animals.

About 15,000 years ago, the relationship between humans and wolves changed. Some wolves started living closer to people. They ate food scraps near camps and offered protection. Over many generations, these wolves became the first domestic dogs.

In more recent history, wolves were hunted heavily. As farming grew, many people saw wolves as enemies. By the 20th century, wolves had disappeared from many regions, especially in Europe and the United States.

Today, the situation is slowly improving. Conservation programs have helped wolves return to some areas. Wolves continue to play an important role in nature because they keep the balance of prey populations such as deer. Their story shows the deep connection between humans and wildlife.
